We are \$8,000- short of the funds that we would like to raise. \$2,200- was raised so far. We are looking into having a professional video the show and we will sell a DVD. Videos are important for colleges and we have parent interest.

Greg Minnie handed in a grant proposal and will have an answer by December. There is currently a \$2,000- grant for a workshop.
