#### PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

- Discussion of school shut down
- Possible return after Thanksgiving on Monday, November 30th if the city falls below the 3% COVID infection rate.
- Confident that the school year will return to normal in September with the implementation of a vaccine.
- Pupil Path notices for students to stick to their schedule for remote learning.
- Calendar of live classes will be released on Monday, November 23rd through Pupil Path.
- 8th grade families will be invited into a Zoom meeting via Pupil Path to discuss high school applications.
- 9th grade families have the option go through the high school application process to transfer schools
- Zoom chat request for more live instruction teachers are only required to have 1 day of live teaching
- Students are not required to have their cameras on, however teachers will reach out to a student that is regularly in class with a camera off.
- Awaiting State decision about Regent exams.
- No graduation date for 12th graders yet. Will confirm soon. Graduation will likely be virtual.
- College board exams prep courses continue virtually. Awaiting decision on exam procedures.
- AP exams will happen in person, in the building, in the Spring.
- Handful of teachers are conducting live classes via video in the PPAS building, most are working from home.
- Any students that need books for classes, they can be picked up at the front door of the school.
